From The Principal's Desk

Dear Parents,

Student safety is one of our primary concerns at Oakcrest. We have taken numerous steps in insure student safety:



1. SUPERVISION: Eight staff members are on duty outside before and after school. Adult supervision is also provided during all student recesses.
2. SAFETY COMMITTEE: Our school has an active Safety Committee that meets at least once each quarter. Safety issues are discussed and action plans formulated.
3. SAFETY DRILLS: Emergency drills are conducted on a routine basis. Procedures are in place for fire emergencies, lockdown situations, chemical spills, and earthquakes. Along with all other schools in the Jordan School District, we have implemented the Incident Management System that allows our emergency responses to correspond with those of municipal fire and law enforcement agencies. Each classroom has been provided with emergency materials that are taken outside during each drill.
4. ABSENTEE CALLING: When students are absent without being accounted for a call is made to their parents' home or work to verify the absence.
5. PLAYGROUND SCANS: All students are asked to immediately line up near their grade level doors in the morning. Staff members who pick up the students from these lines in the morning visually scan the playground to ensure that all students are in class.
6. CHECKOUT PROCEDURES: Photo ID is required when students are checked out during the school day. An individual who is checking out a student must be listed on our pink registration cards.
7. ENFORCEMENT OF SCHOOL RULES: Our school rules are actively enforced. Positive rewards as well as consequences are applied. More severe infractions result in suspensions and the like.
8. USE OF GRADE-LEVEL DOORS: Students are asked to use their grade-level doors when exiting the building at the end of the day. Experience has shown that student safety is enhanced when students proceed to the bus area outside of the building where there is sufficient space to accommodate all students.

9. **SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM:** Our school has been equipped with an advanced surveillance system that includes exterior as well as interior cameras. In addition to helping ensure student safety, this system also helps prevent after-hours vandalism.
10. **OFFICE CHECK-IN:** Visitors, as required by law, are asked to sign in at the office upon arrival at school. Volunteers and substitute teachers are provided with identification badges (Staff members also wear badges with photo identification)
11. **PICK-UP and DROP-OFF PROCEDURES:** The Safety Committee has carefully developed the rules for the pick-up/drop-off lane. Please remember to have students exit only near the curb. Also, please remember that if students are picked up in the east parking lot, parents must park and walk their students across the crosswalk.

As mentioned above, our safety procedures and guidelines are constantly reviewed and refined in Safety Committee meetings, general staff meetings, and by grade level teams. Student safety is our paramount concern at Oakcrest.

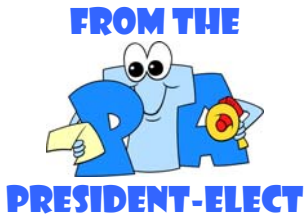

Be sure to speak with your student's teacher if you have any questions concerning this month's curriculum focus.

**Kindergarten:** math-addition, begin subtraction, and measurement. Language arts will be writing skills, review beginning, ending, and vowel sounds. Continue to practice sight words at home. Units of study will be wind, weather, and Spring.

**First Grade:** will continue learning about time, money, as well as beginning place value. We will also be learning about Easter, animals, and life cycles. Review for end of year testing. Remember to read for at least twenty minutes every night.

**Second Grade:** will focus on double digit subtraction, measurement, maps and mapping. We will visit U-tips for end of end review. Continue reading and comprehending.

**Third Grade:** will learn about geometry, heat/energy, Ultrakey, writing poetry, measurement, cursive, living/nonliving, and U-tips.

**Fourth:** will concentrate on fractions, geometry, measurement, probability, plants and animals of Utah, fossils. rocks, minerals, and Utah social studies.

**Fifth:** Math-geometry and fractions; Social Studies-the westward expansion and the Civil War; Science-matter and magnetism; Reading-literacy circles using fictional novels; Language arts-working on state reports.

**Sixth:** Math-integers, measurement, and problem solving; Science-heat, light, and the solar system; Literature-studying and writing about myths, persuasive writing, and poetry.

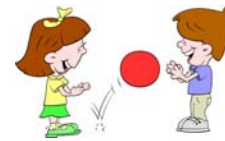

#### The Trust of Our Children 610.5 (March 19, 2009)

There's no doubt about it: Trust is an asset to any relationship, and distrust is an enormous liability. But thinking of trust in terms of its practical value can demean and distort its true significance as an endorsement of our character and as a sign of our worthiness.

I get my clearest vote of trust when I appreciate the ways my young daughters trust their daddy. Knowing they have unquestioned confidence that I will always do the right thing is a source of pleasure and pride.

It's also a source of duty. The trust of our children is a gift we must never take for granted. Trust is fragile. Children trust us completely – until we prove ourselves unworthy. It's a heavy responsibility to protect our kids from our own moral frailties, but I'm a better person because I treasure their trust so much. The glow of their faith in me lights the way and helps me to see traps and hazards that could embarrass them or damage their image of me. Frankly, I can't think of any gain worth that price.

In Arthur Miller's play "All My Sons," the father adores his son and the son idolizes his father – until he learns his father did some shabby things in the past. As the son's esteem slips away, his father says in a desperate plea, "Son, I'm no worse than anyone else!"

The son, with teary eyes, replies, "I know, Dad. But I thought you were better."

There are many reasons to be ethical, but for those with children, there's none stronger than the honor of earning their admiration.
